



## EMLDS – ACCOMMODATION

### • NOVA Student Residences

NOVA University Lisbon offers a limited number of student residences, but availability is highly competitive, with priority given to students with greater financial need. EMLDS students who are scholarship holders have a limited chance of obtaining a room in these residences.

For each annual cohort, the EMLDS Programme Management establishes these contacts and informs students if any rooms become available.

### • 1/4 NETWORK / REDE 1/4

The 1/4 Network is an initiative launched by NOVA University Lisbon aimed at encouraging families and individuals with a spare room in their home (or another property) to offer accommodation to higher education students.

Accommodation may be provided:

- **Under a tenancy agreement**, in exchange for an affordable rent, allowing students to benefit from support and companionship while maintaining a secure and stable contractual arrangement.
- **Under a loan-for-use arrangement (*comodato*)**, in exchange for support and companionship.

The initiative also seeks to encourage institutions and other property owners to make suitable rooms available on the rental market for student accommodation.
